Countable Nouns/Common Noun Have to Numbers:-

- 1. Singular Number
- 2. Plural Number

Singular Number

A noun that stands for only one *person*, *animal*, *place* or *thing* is said to be in the **singular Number**

Examples – boy, bird, apple, Toy, Table, Pen, Chair, Cat.

Plural Number

A noun that stands for more than one *person*, *animal*, *place* or *thing* is said to be in the **plural number**.

Examples – boys, birds, apples, Tables, Pens, Chairs, Cats.

Singular and Plural Rules for class 3

Rule 1: Addition of 's' to change into Plural form. (Most of the nouns take 's')

For Example : Hen – Hens, Rat- Rats, Boy- Boys, Book- Books

Singular	Plural
Friend	Friends
Tree	Trees
Book	Books
Girl	Girls
Animal	Animals

Rule 2: Add 'es' when nouns end in- ch, x, s and ss.

For Example : Branch- Branches, Box- Boxes, Plus- Pluses, Class- Classes.

Singular	Plural
Box	Boxes
match	matches
Bush	Bushes
Branch	Branches

Glass Glasses

Rule 3: Nouns that end in a 'vowel + Y' take the letter 's'.

For Example : Ray - Rays

Singular	Plural
donkey	donkeys
ray	rays
boy	boys
Valley	valleys
essay	essays

Rule 4: Nouns that end in a 'consonant + Y' take the letter 'ies'.

For Example : Baby - Babies

Singular	Plural
puppy	puppies
fairy	Fairies
story	Stories
Family	Families

Party Parties

Rule 5: Noun that end in 'o' take 'es'.

For Example : Mango - Mangoes

Singular	Plural
mango	mangoes
torpedo	torpedoes
volcano	volcanoes
domino	dominoes
potato	potatoes

Rule 6: Some Nouns that end in 'o' take only 's'.

For Example : Photo - Photos

Singular	Plural
Photo	Photos
Ratio	Ratios
Radio	Radios
Piano	Pianos

Kilo Kilos

Rule 7: Some nouns ending in 'o' may take both 's' or 'es'.

For Example : Bufallo – Buffalos/Buffaloes

Singular	Plural
zero	zeros/zeroes
bufallo	bufallos/bufalloes
mango	mangos/mangoes
cargo	cargos/cargoes
tornado	tornados/tornadoes

Rule 8: Noun that end in 'f' or 'fe' usually change the f sound to v and add 's ' or 'es'.

For Example : – Thief- Thieves

Singular	Plural
Life	Lives
Wife	Wives
Leaf	Leaves

Hoof hooves
thief Thieves

Rule 9 : Some nouns are exception, they end in 'f' or 'fe' but they do not change the f sound to v, They take 's'

For Example : Giraffe - Giraffes

Singular	Plural
Giraffe	Giraffes
Roof	roofs
Chief	Chiefs
cafe	cafes
belief	beliefs

Rule 10: There are several nouns that do not follow any rules and have irregular plural form.

For Example : Teeth - Tooth

Singular	Plural
fish	fish
deer	deer

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sheep	sheep
mouse	mice
man	men
child	children
foot	feet
goose	geese
person	people
woman	women
OX	oxen
