

Noun Gender For Class 4

Read these sentences.

1. Alex and tom are brother and sister.
2. The child is playing outside in the garden.

As you see in the first sentences Alexa is the name of a girl and Tom is the name of a boy whereas **Alex is female, therefore belongs to the feminine gender.** Similarly, **Tom is a boy and belongs to the masculine gender.**

In the second sentence, **the child stands for both boy and girl and therefore belongs to a common gender.**

Let us study gender in detail.

1. Feminine Gender

The noun that refers to the woman, girls, and female animals is known as the feminine gender. Lady, mother, sister, princess, and queen are some words that describe the feminine gender.

2. Masculine gender

The noun that refers to the boys, male and male animals is known as masculine gender. Father, brother, king, boy, and man are some words that describe the masculine gender.

3. Common gender

The noun that refers to both the male and female gender is known as the common gender. Parents, baby, teacher, friend, and animal are some words that describe common gender.

Let us learn about some masculine and feminine gender in the table below.
