


Synonyms and Antonyms For Class 4

Synonyms: Synonyms are words that have the same meaning or are similar in meaning to given word. For example, we can say that the *synonym of happy is cheerful and joyful*.

In a language instead of repeating the same word, again and again, is so over, therefore, we use synonyms to make it interesting and not boring as it also increases the vocabulary of the student.

Antonyms: An antonym is a word that has opposites meaning. The words are completely different from each other. The antonyms compare one individual to another which makes it completely different from the other word.


For example: He is a good boy.


