

Noun Gender For Class 3

Gender refers to the characteristics of women, men, girls and boys that are socially constructed.

In English grammar gender indicates a noun or pronoun in Masculine, Feminine, common and neuter gender. There are nouns related to the peoples and names which have different genders.

There are four types of gender:-

1. Masculine gender
2. Feminine gender
3. Common gender
4. Neuter gender

1. Masculine Gender

The masculine gender refers to the male in the category of a person or an animal. *Boy, Grandfather, Goose, son, priest, etc* are some examples of masculine gender.

2. Feminine Gender

The female gender refers to the female in the category of a person or an animal. *Girl, princess, mother, daughter, and lioness* are some examples of feminine gender.
