

Vowels and Consonants for Class 2


In the English language, there are 26 English alphabets. They can be written in capital letters and small letters.

Capital letters



B C D E F G H I J K L M
N O P Q R S T U V W X Y Z

Small letters



a b c d e f g h i j k l m
n o p q r s t u v w x y z

The alphabets are divided into two parts:

1. Vowels
2. Consonants

1. Vowels

Vowels are the letters that produce long sounds. There are **five vowels that are: a, e, i, o, u.**

Examples:-

1. **Cat**
2. **Bat**

2. Consonants

Consonants are letters that do not have any long sound. There are twenty-one in alphabets (**b, c, d, f, g, h, j, k, l, m, n, p, q, r, s, t, v, w, x, y, z**)

Examples:-
